

**You will soon receive a letter in your mailbox**

In the coming weeks, you will receive an invitation to bowel cancer screening in your mailbox. If bowel cancer is detected early, there are better treatment options. Screening can also detect polyps that can be removed before they develop into cancer.

**Is bowel cancer screening relevant for you?**

If you have or have had bowel cancer, screening is not relevant for you. You can opt out at [www.sundhed.dk](http://www.sundhed.dk) or contact the Screening Secretariat in your region.

If you are currently receiving treatment for a disease in the colon or rectum, or if you have regular colonoscopies as part of a follow-up programme, please contact your hospital department. They can advise you whether bowel cancer screening is relevant or not.
